### **Kenosha County Household Hazardous Waste Program**

Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser today is announcing this year's Household Hazardous Waste Program.

“The Kenosha County Household Hazardous Waste Program is a FREE program and a great opportunity for County, non-City residents to dispose of their household hazardous waste in an environmentally friendly way,” Kreuser said.

Residents of the City of Kenosha already have a free Household Hazardous Waste Program through the Kenosha Water Utility. On the first Saturday of every month, between the hours of 8 AM and 11 AM, City residents can drop off their household hazardous waste at the Kenosha Water Utility on Green Bay Road.

For people living in Kenosha County, outside the City of Kenosha, the Kenosha County Household Hazardous Waste Program was established. This year, County residents will have an opportunity to dispose of their Household Hazardous Waste for FREE, on Saturday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> and Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup>. Household Hazardous Waste items include: household cleaning products, bug sprays, batteries, vehicle fluids and cleaning products, oil based paints, paint related products, fluorescent bulbs, pool chemicals and garden/outdoor related products.

The May 2<sup>nd</sup> collection date is from 8 AM – 1 PM at the Kenosha County Center, 19600 75<sup>th</sup> Street in the Town of Bristol; the September 12<sup>th</sup> collection date is from 8 AM – 1 PM at the Pleasant Prairie Municipal Center, 8600 Green Bay Road in the Village of Pleasant Prairie.
