Post Judgment Divorce/Paternity

Order To Show Cause

This form is used to order the other party into court on a specific date. If you are bringing more than one issue to the court's attention, use one (1) **Order to Show Cause** form, but you must attach all the **Affidavits** that are specific to your case. You are encouraged to seek some legal assistance to verify that these forms are the most appropriate for your situation, as the Court's staff cannot give legal advice.

1. Complete the caption (top portion) of the **Order to Show Cause** the same way it appeared in your original Divorce or Paternity papers.
 - Mark an **X** in the box to indicate if this matter is in relation to a Marriage or a Paternity. If Paternity, write the initials of the child(ren) for which this Paternity is regarding.
 - Write the first name, middle initial, and last names of the parties in the same order in which it was completed in your original Divorce or Paternity papers.
 - Call the Child Support Division at (262) 697-4500 to determine if the State of Wisconsin is a party to this case. Mark only one box with an **X** to report if the State is a party to the case or not.
 - Write in your case number.
2. Write the other party's name in the paragraph entitled **It is Ordered**.
3. Leave the portion blank below the section entitled **It is Ordered**- the court will complete this portion.
4. Mark an **X** in the box of the last paragraph to indicate whether this matter is related to financial matters or not.
