

# City of Kenosha, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, April 5, 2005

## Instructions for Voting on the Voting Machine

1. Step inside the curtains. Move the red handle to the right as far as it will go, and leave it there. This will close the curtains and unlock the machine for voting.
2. You may vote for one candidate in each office, except that you may vote for two candidates for School Board. If you should make a mistake, turn the lever back. Turn the lever next to the candidate of your choice, and LEAVE THE VOTING LEVERS DOWN.
3. You may vote "Yes" or "No" on the referendum questions. If you should make a mistake, turn the lever back. LEAVE THE VOTING LEVERDOWN.
4. To Cast A Write-In Vote: Check ballot for slide number. Press and hold in button located in far upper left hand corner of the machine, this releases the metal slide. Locate proper slide number on left side of machine. Push metal slide opposite slide

number to right to open. You can write in the name of your personal choice on the exposed paper of the corresponding slide number.

5. To register your vote leave the voting levers down. Move the red handle to the left to register your vote and open the curtains.

You can make as many changes as you desire, as no votes are registered until you return the red handle to the left of the machine. The machine is so arranged that you can turn down only the proper number of voting levers for each office. You cannot spoil your ballot, by voting for too many candidates. Each candidate's voting lever is located to the right of the name. A large "X" will appear when you have voted the candidate of your choice. LEAVE THE VOTING LEVERS DOWN. No one will know how you have voted because the movement of the Red Handle to the left, returns the voting levers to the original position before the curtains begin to open.
