County Director of Veteran Services to Retire

Kenosha, WI – Thomas R. Lois will end his 21 year career as Kenosha County Director of Veteran Services October 31, 2008.

Lois accepted the appointment by County Executive John Collins in June of 1987. As director, Lois coordinated the activities of the Veteran Services Office which is responsible for helping the county's veterans. Duties include advising veterans about benefits, counseling returning veterans and coordinating veterans' activities, among others.

Lois served in the Army from 1967 to 1970. Lois is a combat veteran of Vietnam and Army Special Forces.

“Tom leaves this job with a legacy of significantly improving the lives the county veterans,” said County Executive Jim Kreuser. “His expertise in keeping the office's services available to veterans will be a difficult act to follow.”
