MEDIA INVITATION

Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser today is announcing that he will attend a news conference at 1:30 p.m. on Friday, January 16 at Brass Ball Mobil, 25406 75th St., Paddock Lake, where details of a proposed federal stimulus package plan will be discussed.

Kreuser, in cooperation with other area and state elected officials, will voice their support for the program, known as “A Plan.” Officials will be joined at the news conference by small business owners from the area, and Carl R. Edenhofer Jr., owner of Brass Ball Mobil and the author of A Plan.

Edenhofer said he drafted the stimulus program in response to Congress and the President not hearing the voices of the people on the street regarding the economy.

Kreuser and other officials in attendance will sign a joint request asking the Wisconsin Congressional delegation to present A Plan to the full Congress for consideration as part of any additional stimulus program or future distribution of the remaining Troubled Assets Relief Program funds.
