County Executive names PGA-credentialed golf professional to lead county golf operations

Kenosha – Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser today announced that Dan Drier, a PGA-credentialed golf professional, will begin Monday, Feb. 16th as the new General Manager of Golf Operations for Kenosha County.

“Dan has the right kind of experience to lead Brightondale and Petrifying Springs golf courses into the future,” Kreuser said. “Not only does he have a great deal of knowledge about the game, but in his 22 years of experience in the golf industry, he had done everything from cooking hot dogs, to working on the greens and giving golf lessons.”

Drier served during the past 11 seasons as Director of Golf at Lake Lawn Resort in Delevan. Previously, Drier was General Manager and head golf professional at Sherwood Forest Country Club in Sherwood, General Manager and head golf professional at Thornberry Creek Country Club in Oneida. He also had worked as the assistant golf professional at the Brown County Golf Course in Oneida and at Mid-Vallee Golf Course in DePere.

“Dan’s real passion is customer service and I think county golfers will appreciate that,” Kreuser said.

Area golfers might also have heard Drier as the teaching professional on the radio show “Where to Play Golf” on Saturday mornings on WLIP AM 1050.

Drier is a Wisconsin native, born and raised in Green Bay and a graduate of UW-Green Bay with a degree in Business Administration. He is a Class A PGA member in good standing, and graduated from PGA Business Schools 1, 2 and 3.

“I am thrilled to be coming to Kenosha County to work at such outstanding facilities here,” Drier said. “This is an extraordinary opportunity to be part of a great community and participate in bringing the county golf courses to the level that every county resident can be proud of.” The public will get a chance to meet Drier at the Kenosha Area Chamber of Commerce Business Expo 09 on Saturday, Feb. 21 and Sunday, Feb. 22. The event will be held at the UW-Parkside Frank J. Petretti Fieldhouse.
