- Thursday, March 12th, at the Randall Town Hall, 34530 Bassett Road, starting at 5:30 p.m. until the start of the Town Board meeting at 7 p.m.
- Monday, March 23rd, at the Wheatland Town Hall, 34315 Geneva Road, starting at 5 p.m. until the start of the Town Board meeting at 6:30 p.m.; and
- Tuesday, March 24th, at the Paris Town Hall, 16607 Burlington Rd., starting at 5:30 p.m. until the start of the Town Board meeting at 7 p.m.

No appointments are necessary and all county residents are invited to meet with Kreuser to discuss any county-related topic during the “after office hours.”

Kreuser said the “after office hours” sessions are an effort to make county government accessible to all county residents by being available after the typical work day.

“I’m interested in hearing what the people of Kenosha County have to say and to talk about the issues that are important to them,” Kreuser said.

Kreuser thanked the Village of Pleasant Prairie, the Town of Randall and the Town of Wheatland and the Town of Paris officials for welcoming him and making his visit possible.
