Kenosha County Household Hazardous Waste Program

Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser today is announcing this year's Household Hazardous Waste Program.

“The Kenosha County Household Hazardous Waste Program is a FREE program and a great opportunity for County, non-City, residents to dispose of their household hazardous waste in an environmentally friendly way,” Kreuser said.

For people living in Kenosha County, outside the City of Kenosha, the Kenosha County Household Hazardous Waste Program was established. This year, County residents will have two opportunities to dispose of their Household Hazardous Waste for FREE, on Saturday, May 7th and Saturday, September 10th. Household Hazardous Waste items include: household cleaning products, bug sprays, batteries, vehicle fluids and cleaning products, oil based paints, paint related products, fluorescent bulbs, pool chemicals and garden/outdoor related products.

The May 7th collection date is from 8 AM – 1 PM at the Kenosha County Center, 19600 75th Street in the Town of Bristol; the September 10th collection date is from 8 AM – 1 PM at the Pleasant Prairie Municipal Center, 8600 Green Bay Road in the Village of Pleasant Prairie.
