The Kenosha County Department of Public Works announces scheduled work to resurface a segment of CTH "KR" and improve the Canadian Pacific Railroad crossing located on County Trunk Highway "KR", ½ mile east of County Trunk Highway "H" in the Town of Somers.

The Canadian Pacific Railway Company will be reconstructing the existing crossing on County Trunk Highway "KR". The project is scheduled to begin on Monday June 13, 2011 and be completed on Friday June 17, 2011.

The Kenosha County Division of Highways will concurrently be completing an asphalt resurfacing project on CTH "KR" between CTH "H" and the Union Pacific Railroad crossing.

CTH "KR" will be closed to through traffic between County Trunk Highway "H" and County Trunk Highway "EA" for the duration of the railroad crossing reconstruction project. Access will be provided to all residences, businesses and farms. A posted detour route utilizing County Trunk Highway "H", CTH "A" and CTH "EA" will be in place.

Part of the asphalt resurfacing project will be located east of the closed segment of CTH "KR". Motorists are advised to use caution while travelling through the area where construction crews are working. Flag persons will be directing traffic, but travel delays will occur due to the resurfacing operations. Motorists may want to choose alternative routes to avoid the active construction zones.
