Streets and Highways

Arterial Highways

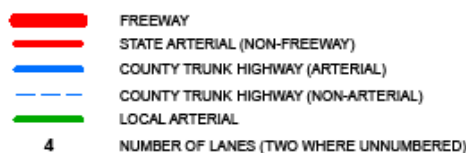
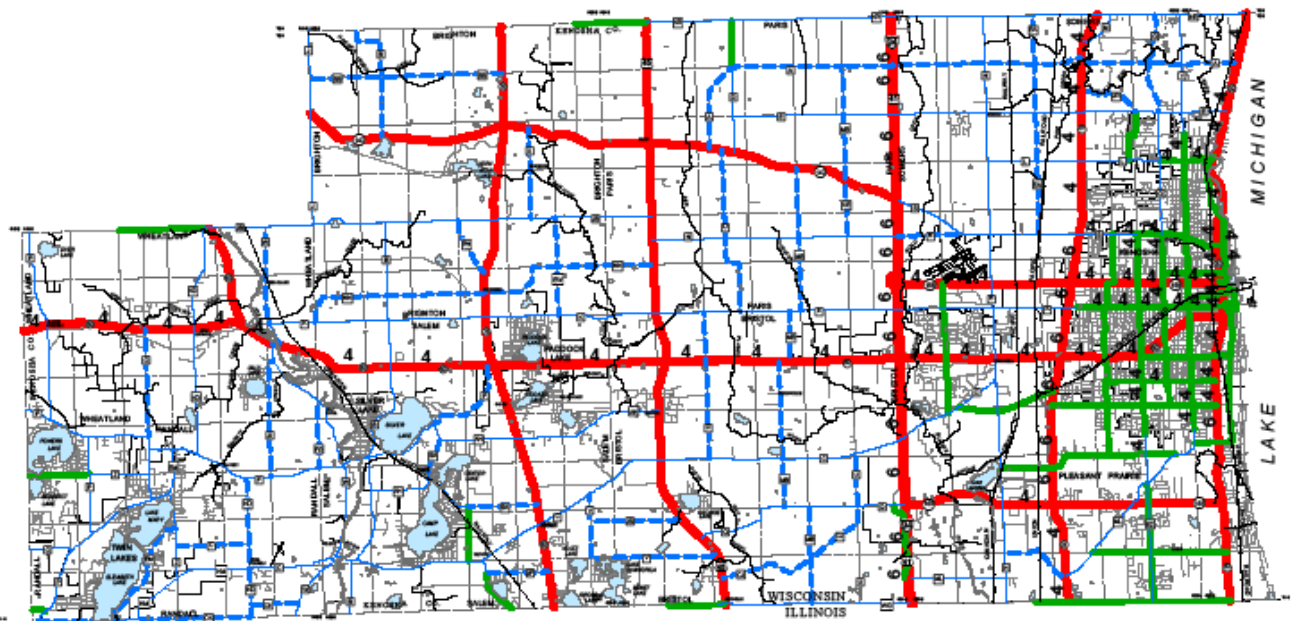
In 2006, there were approximately 43 miles of arterial streets and highways in the Town of Paris. (Arterial streets and highways carry traffic between communities and to destinations beyond the County.)

- 15.9 miles of arterial highways in the Town in 2006 are under the jurisdiction of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
- 22 miles of arterial highways are under the jurisdiction of Kenosha County.
- 2.0 miles of arterial streets are under the jurisdiction of the Town of Paris

Collector and Land Access Streets

- In 2006, there were approximately 29.8 miles of collector and land access streets in the Town of Paris, including 16.1 miles of non-arterial highways under the jurisdiction of Kenosha County.

Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities

A 4.4-mile on-street bikeway is located along CTH KR in the Towns of Paris and Somers, and is part of a Racine County bike route. This route connects to a system of bikeways extending north into Racine County.

Specialized Transportation Services

Kenosha Care-A-Van and the Volunteer Escort Service (both provided by the Kenosha County Department of Human Services) offer door-to-door transportation services to individuals who are elderly, disabled or assessed as unable to use other transit services.

Rail Freight Services

Rail freight service in Kenosha County includes three railway companies (Union Pacific Railway, Canadian Pacific Railway, and Canadian National Railway) over approximately 50 miles of track. There is no freight rail service in the Town of Paris.

Airports

There are no airports or heliports in the Town. General passenger service is provided by General Mitchell International Airport in Milwaukee County. Public-use airports in Kenosha County include the Kenosha Regional Airport, Westosha Airport, Camp Lake Airport, and Vincent Airport.
