Inventory of Community Facilities

Town Hall, Post Office, and Library

- The Salem Town Hall Office is located in the east central portion of the Town on Antioch Road (State Highway 83). The Salem Public Works Building is located on 258th Court.
- The U.S. Post Office has 4 facilities in the Town of Salem: one in the hamlet of Camp Lake (Camp Lake Road), one in the hamlet of Salem (83rd Place), one in the hamlet of Trevor (Wilmot Road-County Highway C), and one in the hamlet of Wilmot (113th Street).
- The Salem Community Library is located on 89th Street.

Police, Fire Protection, and Emergency Rescue Services

- Police protection in the Town of Salem is provided by the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department, which is based in the City of Kenosha on 55th Street.
- Fire protection is provided by the Town of Salem Fire Department, which maintains 2 fire stations.
- The Town of Salem Rescue Squad provides initial response emergency rescue services to most areas within the Town and to eastern portions of the Town of Brighton, as well as Advanced Life Support services to all of Salem and Brighton. The Village of Silver Lake Rescue Squad provides initial response emergency rescue and Advanced Life Support services to the remaining northwest portion of the Town.

Schools

The Town of Salem lies within four elementary school districts:

- Salem School District (encompasses the eastern portion of the Town of Salem) operates Salem Grade School
- Silver Lake Joint School District (central portion)
- Trevor-Wilmot Consolidated Grade School District (southwestern portion) operates Trevor Charter School, Trevor Grade School, Wilmot Bright Horizons Charter School, and Wilmot Grade School
- Wheatland Joint School District (northwestern portion)

Public high school students living in the eastern portion of ~~the~~ Town are in the Westosha Central High School District, and they attend Westosha Central High School in the Village of Paddock Lake. Those living in the western portion of Town attend Wilmot Union High School, operated by the Wilmot Union High School District.

Cemeteries

There are 4 cemeteries in the Town of Salem, encompassing a total of 13 acres: Liberty Cemetery, Salem Mound Cemetery, Union Cemetery, and Holy Name of Jesus Cemetery.

Health Care Facilities

There are no hospitals or clinics for non-specialized medical services located in the Town of Salem, but health care facilities are located nearby in Kenosha County communities, including the Aurora Medical Center,

Children's Hospital of Wisconsin, and United Hospital System-Kenosha Medical Center Campus in the City of Kenosha, and St. Catherine's Medical Center in the Village of Pleasant Prairie.

Child Care Facilities

Child care facilities in the Town of Salem include:

- 4 licensed group child care center (serving 9 or more children): Extensive Fun and Learning; Roots and Wings Child Care Center; The Red Balloon Nursery School; and Westosha Head Start
- 4 licensed family child care centers (serving 4-8 children): April's Child Care; Lite and Brite Day Care; Precious Few Child Care; and Quality Child Care
