Streets and Highways

Arterial Streets and Highways

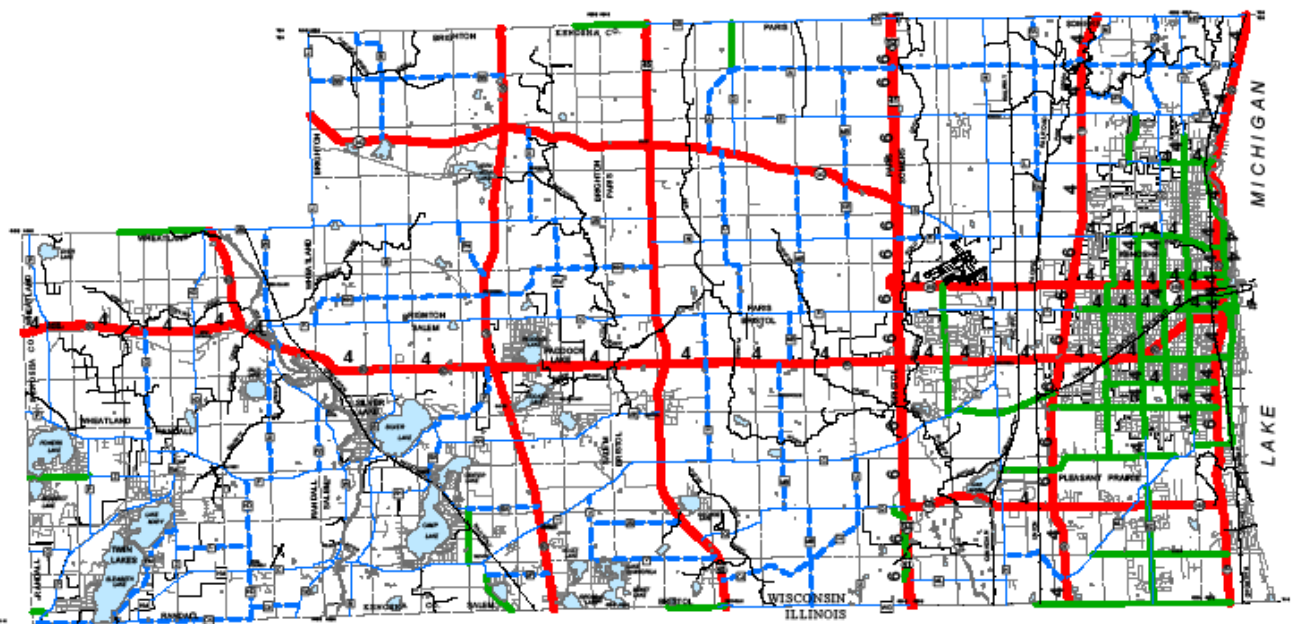
In 2006, there were approximately 24 miles of arterial streets and highways in the Town of Wheatland. (Arterial streets and highways carry traffic between communities and to destinations beyond the County.)

- 8.3 miles of arterial highways in the Town in 2006 are under the jurisdiction of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation
- 14.1 miles of arterial highways are under the jurisdiction of Kenosha County
- 1.8 miles of arterial streets are under the jurisdiction of the Town of Wheatland

Collector and Land Access Streets

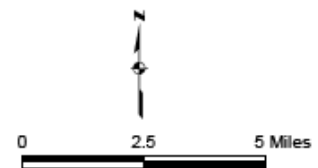
In 2006, there were approximately 31.2 miles of collector and land access streets in the Town of Wheatland including 5.3 miles of non-arterial highways under the jurisdiction of Kenosha County.

Other Transportation Facilities and Services

Specialized Transportation Services

Kenosha Care-A-Van and the Volunteer Escort Service (both provided by Kenosha County Department of Human Services) offer door-to-door transportation services to individuals who are elderly, disabled or assessed as unable to use other transit services.

Rail Freight Services

Rail freight service in Kenosha County includes three railway companies (Union Pacific Railway, Canadian Pacific Railway, and Canadian National Railway) over approximately 50 miles of track. A segment of the Canadian Pacific Railway crosses diagonally through the northeast corner of the Town.

Airports and Heliports

There is one privately-owned and privately-used airport (Foxwood) and no heliports in the Town. General passenger service is provided by General Mitchell International Airport in Milwaukee County. Public-use airports in Kenosha County include the Kenosha Regional Airport, Westosha Airport, Camp Lake Airport, and Vincent Airport.
